Dear. Dr. Eccles: Please note that we have accepted all recommended changes, and made revisions in answer to the two questions. We have also made two additional edits previously overlooked, specifically, on p. 14 of the tracked version, under "Sample", line 1, we've inserted a missing word, namely "constructed", following "geographically-". In the first quotation on p. 17 of the tracked version, line 5, we've revised the wording of the boldfaced interpretation to create parallelism with other interpretive notations, so that "...a facilitator as an organization" has been changed to read "... a macro/organizational facilitator to KT".
